## Required Materials and documents :

- need tax/income info. (1080, W2, etc...) for you and your parents
  - ↳ note: it's okay if you haven't submitted your taxes if you have an on-campus job, your W2 form will appear under voyager → employee services → tax forms
- cost of attendance for Lawrence and financial aid information
- money spent on tuition, fees, and books

## Next steps part of application requires:

- docuSign or sign after printing consent and confirmation forms.
    - ↳ needed for both the individual and parent
  - Submit and upload: W2 / 1040 forms for parent and individual  
cost of attendance and financial aid  
Identification for permanent address (driver's licence)
- \* note these are just the most general forms required, check the AAMC fee assistance program essentials pdf to get additional information \*

The Fee Assistance Program benefits are subject to change. If you are approved for fee assistance during the calendar year, you will receive the following benefits:

## MCAT Official Prep Products Benefit

- The MCAT Official Prep products benefit package is subject to change. The current MCAT Official Prep products benefit is the [MCAT Official Prep Online-Only Bundle](#) (\$268.80 value), which includes all online MCAT Official Prep products.

You will receive the MCAT Official Prep products benefit *once in a lifetime*, regardless of how many times you are a Fee Assistance Program awardee. Therefore, you must actively elect to receive MCAT Official Prep product benefits. We will provide more details about this benefit if you are awarded Fee Assistance.

## MCAT Benefits

- Reduced [registration fee](#), from \$330 to \$135, for MCAT exams.

*Additional fees will be charged for each medical school designation beyond the initial set of 20.*

Unused medical school designations do not carry over to the next AMCAS application cycle, even if the next application cycle falls before December 31st of the next year after you've been awarded.
